

Thank you for participating in a mediation through Level Path Ministries. The investment you make in preparation will help to ensure a productive experience. Your preparation should include the following:

- 1. Read The Peacemaker by Ken Sande. Take special note of the progression of an idol in chapter 5.
- 2. Read the Rules of Procedure for Christian ConciliationPrepare a Log and Speck List, with your contribution to the conflict and the other party's contribution to the conflict.
- 3. Write an opening statement, two sentences expressing what you hope to see accomplished during the mediation.
- 4. Read the agenda and ground rules for mediation.
- 5. Write notes for your storytelling, usually bullet points that contain information and events that are significant to you in this experience. Include acknowledgement of wrongs, confession of sin and unresolved issues.
- 6. Create a list of issues that you believe need to be resolved related to this conflict.
- 7. Read Ephesians 4:17-32 and write down principles of Christian communication that may be drawn from this passage.
